

Roles & Responsibilities

Mayor – ECC 1-5-4:

The Mayor is sworn in to protect and defend the US constitution, the Idaho Constitution, Idaho Code and Eagle City Code.

The Mayor serves as the chief administrator for the City- presiding over meetings of the Council, setting agendas, processing complaints and overseeing day to day management of the City.

Unlike the City Council, the Mayor only votes to break a tie.



Planning & Zoning

Commission – ECC 2-1-5:

The Planning and Zoning Commission is made up of five mayor appointed & council confirmed members.

The commission is charged with oversight under Idaho Code 67-65: The Local Land Use Planning Act. One of the five members shall be appointed to represent the people outside the City limits but within the Eagle Area of Impact Boundary.



City Council - ECC1-5-5:

The Eagle City Council is made up of four at-large elected officials who are sworn in to protect and defend the US constitution, the Idaho Constitution, Idaho Code and Eagle City Code.

The City Council is the legislative and policy making branch of City government. Charged with oversight of the City finances, improvements & work done for the City.



Design Review Board - ECC 2-2-4:

The Eagle Design Review Board is made up of five mayor appointed and council confirmed design professionals (land use, engineering, architecture, landscape architecture, business & citizen).

The Board reviews both commercial & subdivision applications to confirm compliance with the City's Design Review Standards in Eagle City Code 8-2A.
